Drug fridge	Clean and check temperature (2 – 8oC)	Clean with detergent and hot water	Carer	Daily, deep clean weekly and defrost							
Nebuliser	Check and clean	Detergent wipes	Carer	Daily as per schedule							
Walking Frames	Clean between uses by each resident. check frames and wheels	Clean with detergent and hot water,	Carer (nights)	Daily and After use							
Hoists	Clean between uses by each resident. check frames and wheels	Clean with detergent and hot water	Carer	Daily check deep clean weekly							
Hoist slings	Check after use	Wash in washing machine	Carer	Daily check wash as agreed scedule
